

DAVINA WHITEMAN MEMORIAL TRAINING CLASS

1. All competitors will come in for the initial go round.
2. Phase 1 – each competitor will perform a set show which will include the following moves:

First Ridden –

Walk, Trot and Canter on each rein

Change of rein at trot

Halt for 5 seconds, 5 strides of walk and continue into trot within the show.

All other classes –

Walk, Trot and Canter on each rein

Change of rein at trot

3 loop serpentine at canter with a simple change over the centre line through trot

Extended canter

Rein back

After completing Phase 1 you will then go to the judge for Phase 2.

3. Phase 2 – an individual show of no more than 2 minutes. The show will be judged on the element of 'Showmanship'. The judge is looking for that 'first impression' and style in your show.

After completing Phase 2 you will then go to the judge for Phase 3.

4. Phase 3 – the judge will be looking at the presentation and skill of the In Hand phase. Conformation will not be taken into account.

After completing Phase 3 you will then go to the judge for Phase 4. This will take place in the Official's Marquee.

5. Phase 4 – a small number of questions to discover your general knowledge of showing and preparation required for your type of horse/pony. Children will be allowed a parent present at the interview. Phase 4 will take place in the Official's Marquee. Please wait outside the marquee 10 minutes after completing Phase 3.

All phases will be completed in order of 1-4.
